This could encompass any combination of Carpentry; Ceiling or wall installation; Door/window installation; Dry wall installation; Electrical work; Floor covering; Home furnishing installation; Insulation work; Masonry; Painting; Paperhanging; Plumbing (incidental operations only – up to 10% of receipts); Siding installation; or Tile, stone, marble work. This could apply to either residential and/or commercial renovation/remodeling work. Use **Class 99123** for risks that perform these operations and combine the applicable payroll.
